

Workshop with the American Philosopher Todd May: Care and Memory in Narrative Practice

This addresses how we can understand care and memory in a narrative context. The program is divided into two parts with a lunch break in the middle. The workshop is conducted in English and is open to anyone working with or interested in narrative thinking.

Morning session: Care ethics is a feminist-inspired approach to our ethical relationships, pioneered by Carol Gilligan among others. It emphasizes our engagement with others as a basis for ethics. During the morning session, we will introduce care ethics and explore its implications for ethical and political considerations in narrative relationships.

Afternoon session: The concept of memory is often misunderstood. Our memories are never just reproductions of earlier events; they're colored by what happens in between the remembered event and the act of remembering. This session will discuss the nature of memory and its implications for narrative practice.
